

Ebrahim Academy Admission Policy

Application Procedure

To apply for a placement at the academy, parents are required to complete an application form for their child. This must be accompanied with a copy of a valid Birth Certificate and the most recent school report.

All new admissions will be enrolled on a probationary period of one School Term, which may be extended if required. Upon satisfactory performance of the child, permanent enrolment will be granted by the Management. The academy reserves the right to take any student off roll or refuse admission. Parents have the right to appeal the decision in writing to the head teacher. This must be done within 10 working days.

Admissions – Guidance Notes

It is vital that parents ensure that their applications are submitted by the deadline set by the Academy's management.

Admissions will undertake the following procedure:

- 1.** All students for Year 7 are required to sit the CAT 4 test. We may also undertake Literacy and Numeracy tests if required.
- 2.** Successful applicants will be called in for an interview after which if successful, a placement will be offered.

The Academy policy is not to admit any pupils from Year 11. However any admissions will be at the discretion of the management.
